We support the efforts of land trusts, conservation nonprofits, land management agencies, trail groups, and community organizations who are seeking funding for the following types of initiatives:

Access- projects that enhance and preserve sustainable, legal access to land and water for outdoor recreation.

Stewardship- projects and community engagement events that remediate human-caused degradation to places that host outdoor recreation.

Grants are awarded to specific site projects, not general funding.

Before starting this form, please have all the information about your project site ready, including any cost sheets, maps, project summaries, and/or photo files you'd like to share with onX.

Also, be sure to look up the coordinates for your project site (either an approximate center point of the project area or the access location), as you'll be required to copy and paste the coordinates into this form.

None of the answers will be submitted until the form is complete. We will not receive partially completed applications.
